


Gustafsson allowed Bruguera one last fling when he dropped a point at 40-15 but took the title off the next as Bruguera netted his return.


The evening began in sterling fashion with Todd Woodbridge and Mark Woodforde winning the all-Australian doubles final from Darren Cahill and John Fitzgerald

everybody who had joined hands to make the second Dubai Tennis Open a smashing success. He also General Maktoum, Minister of Defence, UAE, for his continued support.


