# FORMER UAE NO1 PARTAKES IN CHILDREN OF DETERMINATION CLINIC



The Dubai Duty Free Tennis Championships welcomed more than 30 children of determination on Wednesday for a morning dedicated to celebrating the joy of sports and creating a supportive sports community that is both diverse and inclusive.

Led by the former UAE No1 Omar Behrouzian, the dedicated clinic was supported by coaches from the Clark Francis Tennis Academy and focused on helping youngsters from local schools and non-profit organisations to better understand the importance of focus and commitment through a series of fun and friendly drills.

The children showed great enthusiasm as Behrouzian engaged with them for more than an hour. The first Emirati to enter the ATP rankings, he said he always feels honoured to be involved in the annual activation.

# WTA'S 25-YEAR MILESTONE MARKED WITH SPECIAL CEREMONY

A special ceremony was held on Centre Court this week highlighting the WTA's 25-year anniversary in Dubai. Portia Archer, CEO of the Women's Tennis Association, presented Ramesh Cidambi, Managing Director of Dubai Duty Free and Chairman of the Tournament Organising Committee, with a special commemorative collage of the 17 previous winners at the Championships – including Jasmine Paolini, maiden winner Martina Hingis, and seven-time Grand Slam winner Justine Henin.

Meanwhile Breeda McLoughlin, wife of the late Colm McLoughlin, the former Executive Vice Chairman and CEO of Dubai Duty Free, presented Archer with a commemorative trophy to mark the milestone anniversary.
