Three-time finalist faces Tour's most in-form player in a mouth-watering final today



TSITSIPAS AND AUGER-ALIASSIME SET FOR DUBAI FINAL SHOWDOWN



The Dubai Duty Free Tennis Championships wraps up tonight with the men's singles final, as Stefanos Tsitsipas faces a familiar opponent in Félix Auger-Aliassime for the title. They have faced off 12 times across all levels of competition with the head-to-head record on Tour standing at 6-3 in favour of Tsitsipas. A thrilling contest is all but guaranteed.

Tsitsipas, making his third appearance in the Dubai final, is hoping this time will be the charm. The Greek eased past Tallon Griekspoor 6-4, 6-4 in the semi-finals, following strong performances against Karen Khachanov and Matteo Berrettini.

Auger-Aliassime booked his spot in the final after a hard-fought comeback against French qualifier Quentin Halys, winning 5-7, 6-4, 6-3. The World No21 has been in fine form all week, overcoming Alexander Bublik, Nuno Borges, and Marin Čilić on route to the final.

The Championship match is scheduled to begin not before 7:00 PM, with both players ready to leave it all on Centre Court for the coveted Dubai title.

PATTEN & HELIÖVAARA TAKE ON BHAMBRI & POPYRIN IN DUBAI DOUBLES FINAL

Patten and Heliövaara came through a tight semifinal, edging out Robin Haase and Hendrik Jebens 4-6, 6-3, 10-8. On the other side of the draw, Bhambri and Popyrin secured their spot with a 6-2, 4-6, 10-7 win over Jamie Murray and John Peers.

The final takes place on Centre Court at 4:30 PM, with both pairs looking to cap off their week in Dubai with a title.
